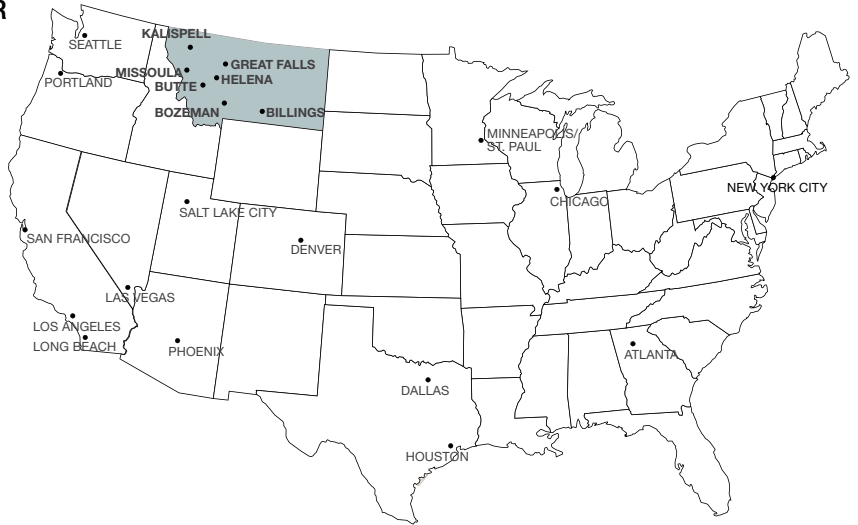

Montana is home to seven regional airports: Billings, Bozeman, Butte, Great Falls, Helena, Missoula and Kalispell/Whitefish. Year-round direct flights are always available through Salt Lake City, Denver, Minneapolis, Chicago, Dallas and Seattle. Seasonal direct flights also include Los Angeles, San Francisco, New York, Houston, Phoenix and Portland. Carriers include Delta, United, American Airlines, Horizon/Alaska Air and Frontier.



MONTANA'S GLACIER NATIONAL PARK: THE CROWN OF THE CONTINENT

Glacier National Park is easy to explore. The Going-to-the-Sun-Road takes visitors through the heart of the park over Logan Pass and is one of the most scenic drives you'll ever take. Summer is the busiest season in the park, Glacier is open year-round. MONTANA'S STATE PARKS CELEBRATE'S 80 YEARS

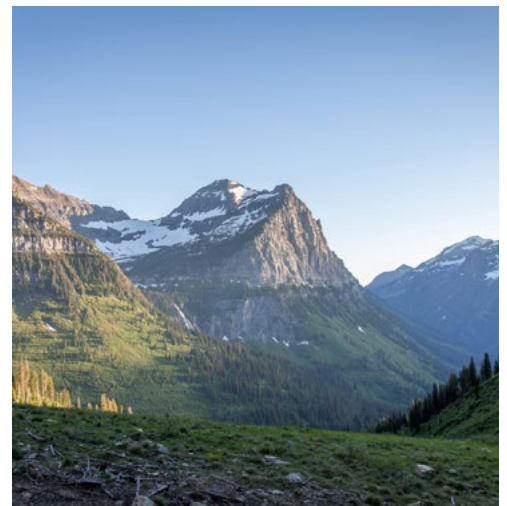

First People's Buffalo Jump State Park near Great Falls is an archaeological site and possibly the largest buffalo jump in North America. Lewis and Clark Caverns State Park features one of the largest known limestone caverns in the Northwest. There are 55 state parks to choose from across the state. stateparks.mt.gov

Near Montana's largest city Billings, visit important historical sites like the Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument where Custer made his Last Stand, and Pompeys Pillar National Monument on the Lewis and Clark Trail. nps.gov/libi/index.htm

Big Sky Resort and Whitefish Resort are just two of Montana's many fabulous ski areas. Big Sky Resort is now home to the only heated 8 person chair lift in North America. Float on the snow and enjoy peaceful winter scenery on a snowshoe trip. Enjoy the rush of gliding through snowy trails behind a dogsled team, or on your own snowmobile, then take a relaxing soak in one of Montana's hot springs. 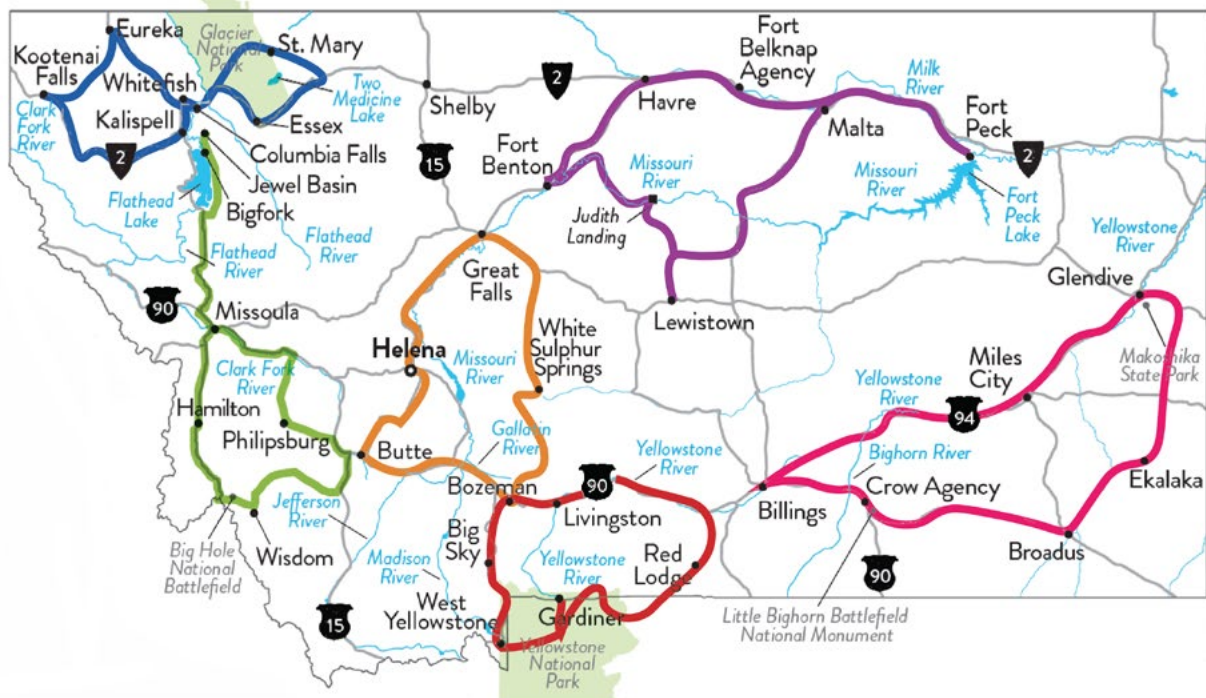
